



## The Asian University for Women Laboratory School Behavior Policy

The Asian University for Women Laboratory School aims to provide world-class education and it is committed to creating and providing a healthy environment that is crime-free and safe. Such an environment helps all students uphold their dignity and self-esteem and helps the students develop all aspects. The Asian University for Women Laboratory School is an environment where all students and faculty are expected to uphold the highest standards in appropriate behavior and exhibit the utmost respect for others, themselves, and the environment.

To maintain such an environment, The AUW Laboratory School prohibits, prevents, and eliminates the scourge of bullying.

Any of the following act(s) will constitute the offense of bullying:

1. Any conduct by any student or students, whether by spoken or written words, an act which has the same effect as teasing, treating, or handling a student rudely.
2. Indulging in rowdy or undisciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any student, be it a fresher or otherwise.
3. Asking any student to do any act that such student will not do in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassment to adversely affect the physique or psyche of a student.
4. Any act by a student that prevents, disrupts, or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student.
5. Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
6. Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a student by other student(s).
7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, assaults, lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
8. Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
9. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a student.
